


ENCINITAS GLEANUP

What's Gleaning?

Gleaning is the practice of collecting and donating surplus produce to local food agencies. Gleaned produce can be used by families in need. It also helps keep excess waste out of landfills.




HELP FEED YOUR COMMUNITY!
