# Next Steps

## **June 20:** Public CCE Exploration Meeting

- Learn what is involved in a technical (feasibility) study
- Consider how best to structure an RFP to elicit proposals that meet our needs and budget

## **June - September:**

- Cities consider whether they are interested in proceeding. If they are, each governing body must pass a resolution stating their interest (no commitment to form a JPA or CCE) to authorize the release of data from SDG&E for a technical analysis.

## **September - October:**

- Interested cities decide how to organize and fund the procurement of a technical study (e.g., scope of work, lead agency, cost-sharing, etc.)

## **Late 2016/early 2017:**

- Issue an RFP for the feasibility study and invite proposals from all interested vendors
- Select vendor and conduct technical study

## **Early 2017:**

- Draft study completed.
- Decide if there is interest in proceeding with a CCE. If so, begin process of forming JPA.
