Rate Increase Effective July 2024

The board approved a 9% rate increase to water rates and service charges on April 17, 2024. New rates will be reflected on all bills effective July 1.

Credit Card Fees Effective July 2024

All credit and debit card payments will be subject to a minimum \$2.50, maximum 3.95% pass through transaction fee effective July1. Cash, check, e-check, and automatic payments from checking accounts will continue to be free. Important Information About Your Drinking Water

As required by the Environmental Protection Agency's Lead and Copper Rule (§141.153(d)(4)(xi)), the San Dieguito Water District has completed its Lead and Copper service line inventory in 2024 and has submitted it to the State for approval before the October 2024 deadline. Air Release & Blow Off Valve Replacement - Phase I Update

The District is replacing air release and blow off valves on Encinitas Boulevard between El Camino Real and Rancho Santa Fe Road and along Rancho Santa Fe Road from Encinitas Blvd to El Camino del Norte in order to update critical infrastructure and continue providing reliable water service. Construction began March 2024 and seven locations have been successfully completed to date. The project will continue to impact traffic flow in the above stated area until completion. AC Pipe Assessment Project

SDWD is conducting a comprehensive assessment of the District's AC water mains. The final report is expected by January of 2025. Once the study is completed, the District will be able to identify and prioritize which segments of our water distribution system require replacement. Use of AC was prevalent in the 60's and 70's due to its corrosive resistance, but its relative brittleness is a drawback in seismically active areas like California and over time it can lose structural integrity, increasing maintenance costs and potential supply disruptions.
