Encinitas has 172 miles of streets, 152 acres of parks, 66 miles of storm drains, and 6 beaches. Underground storm drain infrastructure, more than 50 years old, is deteriorating, polluting our beaches, and causing sinkholes and flooding that threaten homes and businesses. Beaches and marine habitat need protection.

Potholes must be fixed and more roads need repaving. A modern fire station is needed for rapid response in the high fire danger area of Olivenhain. Investing in streets, parks, beaches, beach access, storm drain repairs, and fire safety now will save money over the long run and enhance our quality of life. The longer we wait to make these critical repairs and upgrades, the more expensive they become.
