Community Benefits Overview

 Voluntary program that provides development incentives to developers in exchange for providing extra amenities/improvements.

• Eligibility:

- Office Professional, General Commercial, Public/Semi-Public projects
- Residential or mixed-use projects are NOT eligible to receive these additional incentives

• Process:

- List of Community Benefits with varying number of points granted
- Points granted per unit up to a maximum (per Community Benefit)
- No overall maximum number of development points
- Maximum points redeemable: 90 points:
 - 60 points for Reduced Parking Requirements
 - 30 points for Streamlined Permit Processing max redemption
