SUBJECT: Capital Improvement Program and Traffic Updates

The following are updates for school-related City of Encinitas CIP and Traffic projects:

<u>Streetscape Segment C</u>: Complete Street project from Jupiter to La Costa Avenue. The project will be delivered in phases.

- City received HUD Grant for Drainage Improvements to be constructed with Segment C NEPA analysis complete and finalized
- Council approved construction contract on September 13, 2023
- Held pre-construction meeting December 14, 2023
- Plan began construction in February 2024 and go for 18 months
- City received Coastal Commission approval. NCTD and ROW permit
- 60-inch storm drain installation at Jupiter Street ongoing Traffic has been shifted to western side of 101 to accommodate trenching for 60-inch pipe
- City acquired funding to construct all 60-inch pipe south to Jupiter Street and construction is underway
- Planning to begin on Jupiter Street roundabout in January/February 2025

<u>Santa Fe Drive Corridor ATP</u>: Pedestrian and bike improvements from Gardena to El Camino Real. The project will be delivered in phases

- Council approved Design Plans and specifications on September 14, 2022City received extra \$3.09M from Senator Blakespear to assist with construction funding
- Western Phase construction approved by Council August 27, 2023
- Western Phase includes protected bike lanes and a mid-block ped signal at SDA
- Construction on Western Phase began January 22, 2024. Scheduled to complete Fall 2024 and lead into the Eastern Phase starting in 2025.
- Most Civil work complete. Landscaping to be finished soon on each side of the street.
- Council approved Eastern Phase Design Immunity in May
- Bids received at the end of July and moving to get contract awarded on August 28, 2024
- Eastern Phase to go to construction in early 2025

 Non-Infrastructure grant outreach work to begin around October 2024. Pedestrian counts completed in August

<u>Birmingham Drive Streetscape</u>: New sidewalk, street, pedestrian ramps underground utilities from Interstate-5 to San Elijo Avenue.

- Project approved by Planning Commission August 17, 2023
- Staff is actively seeking funds for construction
- Design of utility relocations ongoing Staff looking at improvements not needing utility relocations

<u>FY23-24 Annual Pavement Rehabilitation Project:</u> Pavement overlay/slurry, ADA upgrades and striping

- Council approved street list in December 2023
- Rodney neighborhood streets in base bid
- Plan to complete intersection of El Camino Real & Manchester in next overlay project
- Project advertised and Bid opening was May 31, 2024
- Contract awarded by Council June 26, 2024
- Construction to occur in Fall 2024/ Winter 2025
- Work commencing on concrete scope around the City, starting at South Coast Highway 101, Vulcan and Manchester. Followed by asphalt paving in mid-October to late-November

<u>FY24-25 Annual Pavement Rehabilitation Project:</u> Pavement overlay/slurry, ADA upgrades and striping

- Council approved street list in June 2024
- City staff returning for Council consideration of revised street list in October, 2024
- Anticipated advertisement and Bid opening in early 2025

Diegueno Middle School:

- Adding bike lanes to Village Park Way near Diegueno Middle School approved by Council December 13, 2023 with Bike Emergency
- Staff received favorable bids on May 14, 2024 after rebidding and City Council approved the contract award on May 22, 2024
- Staff reviewed submittals in July 2024 with construction scheduled for Fall 2024
- Construction is expected to be completed in November 2024

Park Dale Lane:

- Staff complete with design of cross section design options for Park Dale Lane to include a combination of sharrows, bike lanes, parking
- City received HSIP Cycle-11 Grant for intersection improvements at Park Dale Lane & Country Haven Road, Park Dale Lane & Glen Arbor Drive, Park Dale Lane & Willowspring Drive
- Design mostly complete. Expect construction in late Fall/early Winter 2024.

Orpheus Park Bike Path

- Council allocated \$60,000 for the conceptual design of a bike path that will connect the bikeway from Orpheus Park to the PEC school.
- Staff secured a consultant to survey and prepare conceptual exhibits & cost estimates
- Exhibits and cost estimates expected to be sent to City by October 11, 2024

Plan to share with the School District Liaison Committee once received

Olivenhain Trail Fencing

- Constructing approximately 1,000 feet of trail fencing along Rancho Santa Fe Road from Lone Jack Rd
- Council approved construction contract in June 2024
- Construction slows to get started. Targeting completion by December.

Saxony Road And Quail Gardens Drive Mobility Enhancements and Emergency Bicycle Safety Enhancements Projects

- The sidewalk and ramp work at all corners of the Quail Gardens Drive & Ecke Ranch Road intersection has been completed. The roundabout/splitter island material has been ordered and the manufacturer is in the process of building the pieces per the design. Expected lead time is around 8 weeks for this material.
- The contractor is finalizing the traffic control plans for the segments along El Camino Real, Saxony Road, and Village Park Way that are getting a slurry seal, along with the intersections where we will be implementing Cross Bikes and bicycle landing areas.
