A panel of Encinitas residents from each of the five communities along with members of the Commission for the Arts reviewed all submissions.

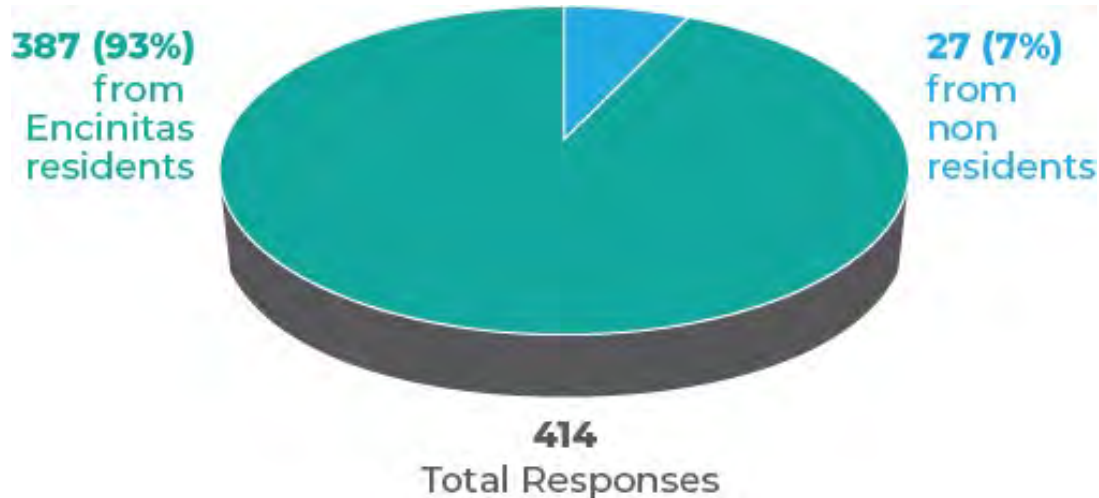
They juried in three sculptures to be considered for recommendation of a two-to-three-year loan to the City.

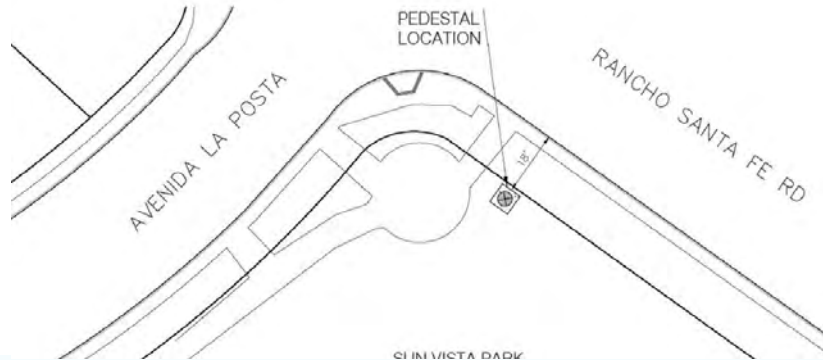
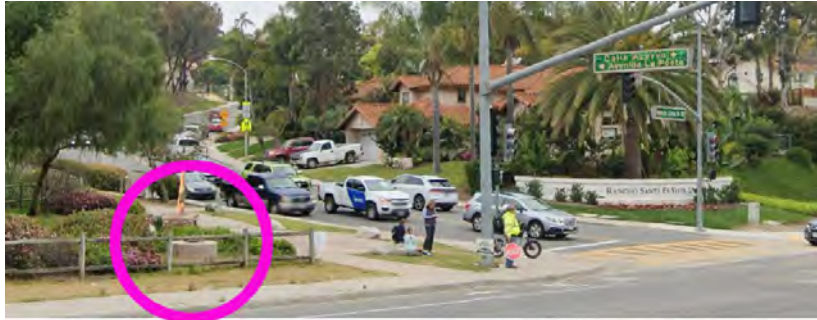
The survey asked the public to rate each of the proposed sculptures on a scale of 1 to 5 for the site at which it was being considered.

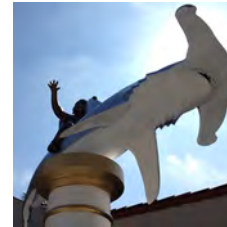

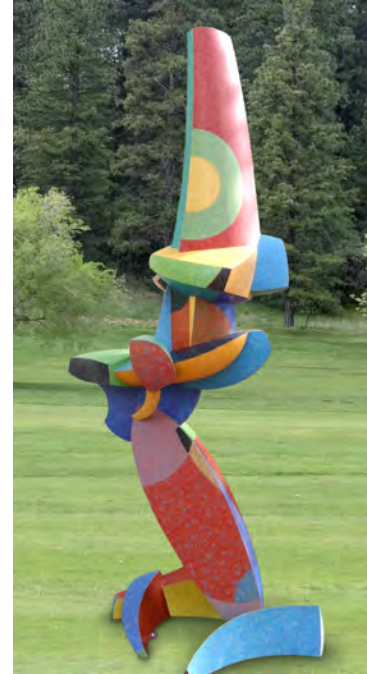

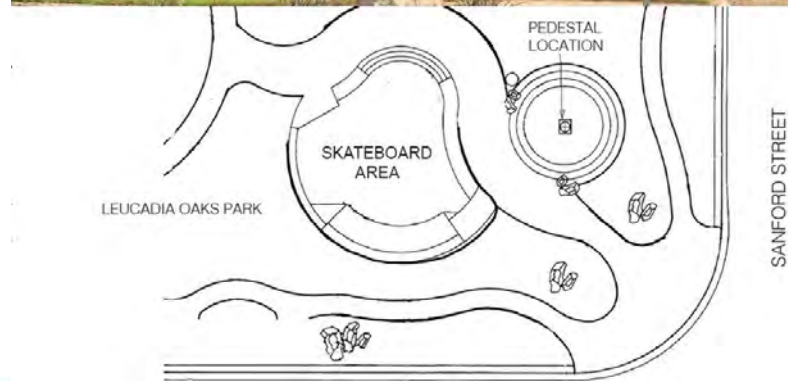
