

## **ATTIC POLICY**

The purpose of this policy is to define the parameters of a qualifying attic for purposes of identifying when the attic space is considered a story for zoning purposes. Encinitas Municipal Code (EMC) Section <u>30.00.060</u> (6.1) limits the number of stories for buildings or structures to a maximum of two. The EMC defines a story as follows:

<u>"Story</u>" - shall mean that portion of a building included between the surface of any floor and the surface of the floor next above it, or if there is no floor above it, then the space between such floor and the ceiling next above it.

An attic shall not be considered a story for zoning purposes when designed with:

- No finished ceilings.
- No finished floor (exceptions may be allowed on a case-by-case basis to support and provide the necessary service area for proposed mechanical equipment).
- No access by a built-in or structural ladder or stairs, except for a standard attic drop-down ladder.
- No windows or skylights.
- Floor joists that are designed to support a maximum of 20 lbs. of live load.

When a project includes a proposed attic, the project plans shall include detailed notes, sections, and structural designs identifying compliance with the qualifying elements listed above.
