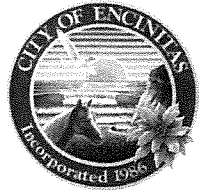

1	Support Business community

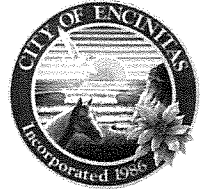
- E-W Crossing - "Access (#/frequency)
 - 2) Don't increase noise (Cardiff) → no open trench!
 - 3) Trench & cover is best sol'n (Land not to develop)
 - 4) Different crossing types for diff. communities
 - 5) Factors may affect crossing choice (Quiet zone, etc.)
 - 6) Desire to have as many as possible



- Desire to grade-separate crossing at Leucadia Blvd (possible) + Chesterfield (not as feasible)
- STRONG Desire to separate bike/ped paths!
 - need on both east + west of tracks (N-S)
 - Desire to connect to rest of City (E-W) (Bridges, ENC. + Manchester Blvd, El Cam. Real?)
- * Need info @ space for paths; quiet zone;
