It was recently brought to our attention that there may be some last-minute discussions on attempting to amend a bill during these last two weeks of the legislative session to limit Community Choice Aggregation commonly referred to as CCA's.

As a result, the City would oppose any legislation that would limit a local government's ability to determine if a CCA is the best option for their residents. The City has worked on this issue for the past two and a half years by having agenda reports, a Council ad hoc subcommittee, public hearings and expert testimony on the subject.

Mark Muir Council Member Last minute gut and amendments or amendments to current legislation will not receive the full public hearing and public process that is necessary for this type of issue, if it is done in the last weeks of the legislative session.

For these reasons, we would oppose legislation that limits CCA's.
