## PROJECT STATUS

In June 2021, the City Council approved the design concept for the Safety and Mobility Enhancements project on Vulcan Avenue. The project went out for construction bids in December 2021. Construction was completed in April 2022.

## PROJECT BUDGET

The project cost was \$94,388 and utilized savings from the Vulcan Avenue Traffic Calming Study Project.

## PROJECT LOCATION

The project is located on N. Vulcan Avenue between Encinitas Blvd and La Costa Avenue.

# Vulcan Avenue Safety and Mobility Enhancements

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

This project improved mobility and safety along N. Vulcan Avenue from Encinitas Blvd to La Costa Ave through the implementation of narrower travel lanes, painted speed legends, Sharrows, raised crosswalks, and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs).

These safety enhancements included narrowing the travel lanes along Vulcan Avenue to 10' wide, shifting vehicles over to the west and creating more space on the east side for pedestrians. In addition, raised crosswalks were installed at the intersections of Andrew Avenue, Sanford Street, and Orpheus Avenue. These locations also benefited from additional signage and RRFBs. Sharrows and speed legends were installed in both travel lanes.

The project supports the City's Strategic Plan goals of Quality Transportation by providing effective, safe and easy transportation for all modes of movement and for all demographics as well as the Community Planning by maintaining safe and livable community through well-maintained infrastructure and facilities.
