This proposed project is located at 948 Neptune Avenue in the Community of Leucadia known as "Beacon's Beach". This application is a request for a Major Use Permit and Coastal Development Permit to allow for modifications to an existing parking lot located along the bluff access point for "Beacon's Beach", just west of Neptune Avenue. Geotechnical investigations have been performed in this parking lot in order to determine the location of a failure plane for the bluff in the event of seismic activity. The western edge of the parking lot has been identified to be past the bluff slope failure plane and the current parking lot pavement and parking lot spaces need to be moved out of the slope area for health and safety concerns.

The project involves re-grading of the parking lot area and restriping the parking spaces, so the front tires of vehicles are outside of this bluff failure plane and the parking dimensions meet current Municipal Code dimensions. Vehicles in the proposed design will be shifted to run along the front of newly located parking spaces. Bluff sensors (or inclinometers) will also be installed along the top portion of the bluff failure plane (near the north end of the parking lot) and within the bluff face (approximately at the mid-point of the bluff) to monitor erosion of the bluff. Underground electrical conduit from the existing power pole on the east side of Neptune Avenue will bring electricity to electrical boxes and the monitoring equipment.

Native hydroseed plant mix will be placed on the exposed sections of the bluff (dirt) once the pavement is removed from the bluff edge and placed behind the failure plane.
