

## SIDEWALK CAFÉ PERMIT PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FEES & INFORMATION

A Public Right-of-Way Sidewalk Café permit is required when any sidewalk or outdoor dining will occur within the public right-of-way.

Approved permits are valid until expiration of insurance and are not transferable to another location.

All fees associated with this permit are non-refundable.

Fees:

Application Fee: New: \$434 Renewal: \$139 Renewal w/Violation: \$239 Business Registration Must have a current business registration with the City. Business

Registration is a separate process and can be applied for

concurrently with this permit.

## **Documentation Required:**

- Certificate Insurance Must have general liability coverage, minimum \$1 million for each occurrence and aggregate for combined bodily injury and property damage. The policy number, effective date, and expiration date must be provided. Work must be completed prior to the expiration date of the policy.
- Plans Sidewalk Cafe Site plan used to depict all proposed private sidewalk café/dining facilities within the public right-of-way including but not limited to tables, chairs, planters, signage, etc. Parking calculations shall be shown.
- Standard Conditions Right-of-Way Construction Acknowledgement of conditions
  which must be adhered to when accessing or performing work in a Public Right-of-Way.
- Stormwater Intake Form & Standard SWQMP
- If alcohol is proposed -
  - Approved use permit/use permit modification.
  - o Approved ABC license reflecting changes/new areas.
