

## TRAFFIC CONTROL PERMIT PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FEES & INFORMATION

A Traffic Control permit is required for any work within a City street that may impact or in any way alter the flow of vehicular, bicycle, or pedestrian traffic.

Approved permits are valid until expiration of insurance and are not transferable to another location.

All fees associated with this permit are non-refundable.

Fees:

Application Fee: \$90 or \$377 depending on the scope of work

Business Registration Must have a current business registration with the City. Business

Registration is a separate process and can be applied for

concurrently with this permit.

## **Documentation Required:**

- Certificate Insurance Must have general liability coverage, minimum \$1 million for each
  occurrence and aggregate for combined bodily injury and property damage. The policy
  number, effective date, and expiration date must be provided. Work must be completed
  prior to the expiration date of the policy.
- Plans Traffic Control Identify construction work-zone limits, description of work to be
  done, roadways, existing signing and striping, speed limits, specify construction duration
  and work hours, temporary traffic control devices (cones, delineators, signs, barricades, krail, etc), vehicle detours, pedestrian detours, existing and proposed lane dimensions, lane
  reduction transition lengths, lane closures. Traffic control plans shall be developed to
  follow the California MUTCD and the San Diego Regional Standard Drawings.
- Standard Conditions Right-of-Way Construction Acknowledgement of conditions which must be adhered to when accessing or performing work in a Public Right-of-Way.
