

## Olympus Park (CP14A)

Promoting Active Lifestyles and Community Health by Furthering Access to Parks



### PROJECT STATUS

The Olympus Park Project began construction in May 2020 and was completed in July 2021.

### PROJECT BUDGET

The total cost for the project's design and construction was \$5.6 Million. The construction contract was awarded to CS Legacy, Inc. for \$4.17 Million.

### PROJECT LOCATION

Olympus park is located in the community of Leucadia at the Southwest corner of Piraeus and Olympus Streets in Encinitas.



### ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Olympus Park Project (originally referred to as the Standard Pacific Park Site) is a 3.41 acre neighborhood park located in the community of Leucadia at the southwest corner of Piraeus and Olympus Streets in Encinitas.

The project was included in the 2016 Parks Master Plan and is widely used by the community. Since its completion, the project has received several awards of recognition, including Project of the Year from the American Public Works Association (APWA).

## PARK AMENITIES

The project consisted of a variety of park amenities, including a dog park, sports court, skate element, pump track, playground, zip line, two-story slide, picnic tables and benches, bike racks, walking paths, tot lot and open turf area.

### Active Spaces:

- Two playgrounds
- Sports court for half-court basketball or Pickleball
- Small skate element features, pump track for bikes, skateboards, and scooters
- Fenced small and large dog park areas with shade
- Zipline

### Passive Spaces:

- Seating and gathering areas with shade structures
- Walking paths, gazebo, botanical plantings and pebble walk
