Look for our new SandSnap Signs at your local beaches to participate in this project!

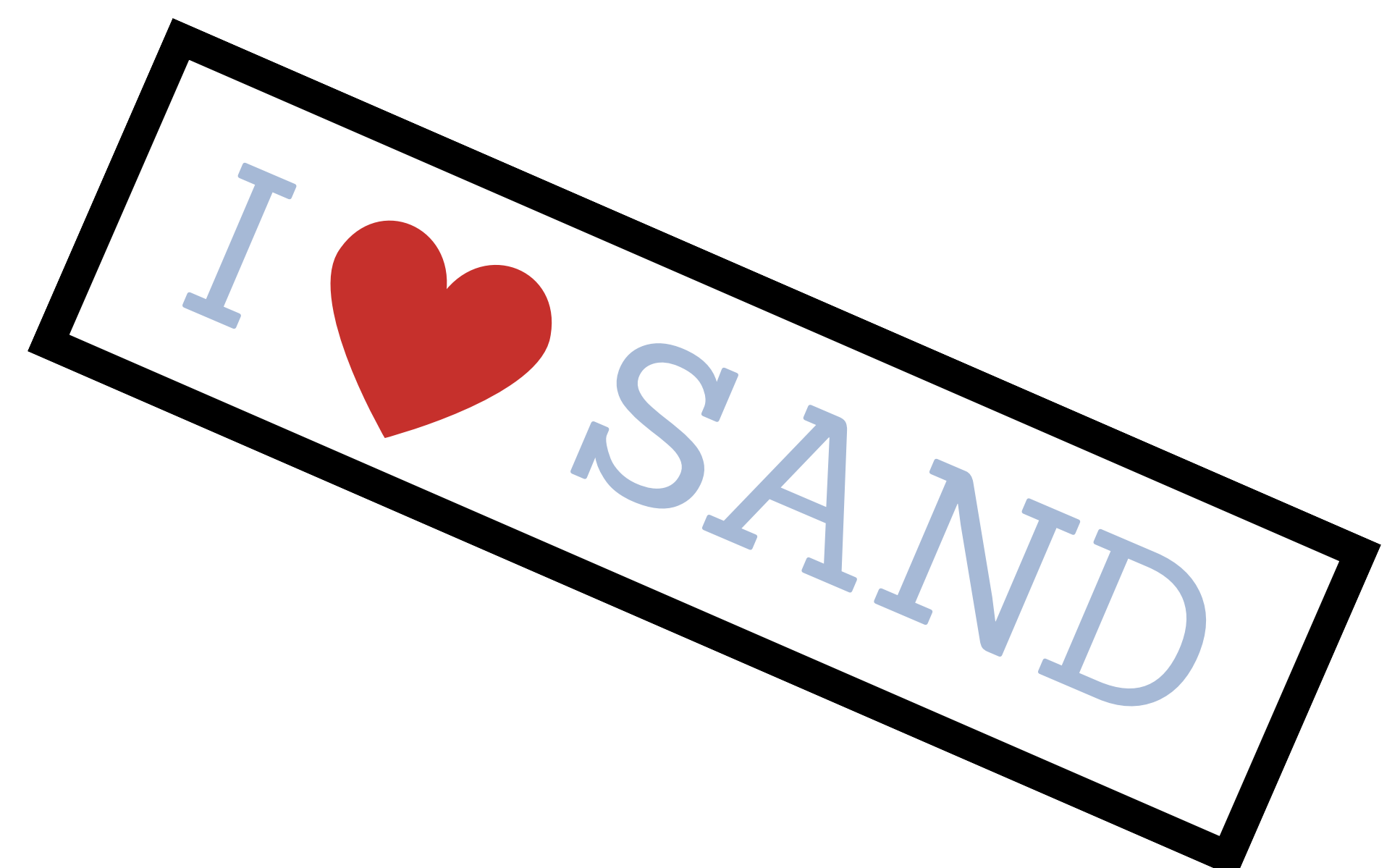


Our Beaches Need Your Help!

Do you want to be part of studying our beaches? All you need is your **smartphone** and a **U.S. coin** to participate! SandSnap is a community developed database of **beach sand grain sizes** collected from your photographs. This data is used by researchers and local officials to learn more about coastal dynamics and make better management decisions.

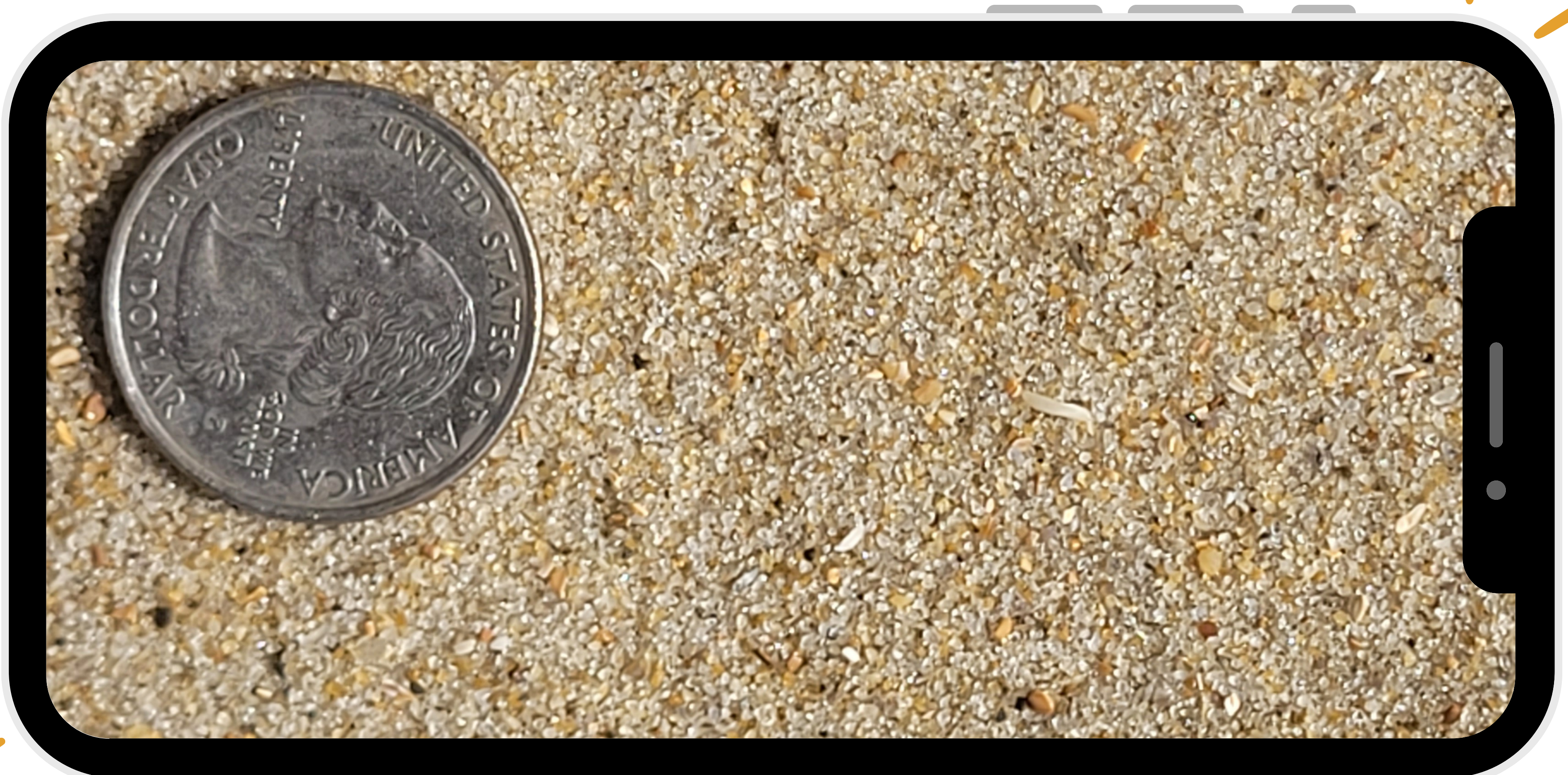
- 1 Go to the beach and find a **sandy area, clear of debris** such as shells, sticks, etc.
- 2 Smooth the sand and place a **U.S. coin**. *Quarter, dime, nickel, penny - all work!*
- 3 **Snap a picture!** *Make sure to focus on the sand and not the coin, and try to avoid shadows.*
- 4 **Scan** the QR code at the bottom of this poster.
- 5 **Upload** your picture, fill out the form, and submit. You're Done!

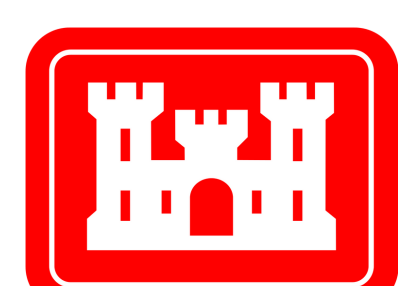
