Introduction

Self-Evaluation

Overview

Under Title II of the ADA, public agencies are required to conduct a Self-Evaluation of their programs and services, and Title I employment policies and practices with regards to accessibility.

The ADA/Section 504 Self-Evaluation is a review of the City's/District's entire public program: facilities on public property, Programs and Services, Human Resources/Employment in order to identify any obstacles or barriers to accessibility that need to be addressed. Process & Findings

The City/District has incorporated accessible pedestrian features as part of the City's/District's capital improvement projects. Any new capital improvements will be designed with the current ADA regulations and standards.

The City/District has integrated both the accessibility barriers identified from the Self-Evaluation along with accessible capital improvement projects with accessible features into the Transition Plan.




Public Outreach
